POLICY STATEMENT:

When scheduling public meetings and events, departments and advisory bodies are to take into consideration Jewish holidays. Below is a list of major Jewish holidays through the year 2000. Observance of each begins at sundown of the previous day.

CITY OBSERVANCE OF THE JEWISH HOLIDAYS LISTED ABOVE IS LIMITED TO THE FIRST DAY ONLY. OBSERVANCE OF EACH OF THESE HOLIDAYS BEGINS AT SUNDOWN OF THE PREVIOUS DAY.

City Council meeting schedules will be reviewed by the City Clerk each year to give Council sufficient advance notice of any conflict between its public meetings and the Jewish holidays listed above.
