Smart Business Rebate Program

The rebate does not apply to sales tax, toilet seats, fittings, or installation charges. The rebate amount is the lesser of the cost of the fixture/washer, or:

High Efficiency Clothes Washer- **\$400**

High Efficiency/ Ultra High Efficiency Toilet- **\$200**

High Efficiency Urinal- **\$300**

Rebate Eligibility Requirements

- ◆ The property must be at a location served by the City of Santa Cruz Water Department.
 - ◆ The effective date of the rebate offer is January 1 through December 31, 2014 while funds are available. Toilets, urinals, or washers must be purchased during this period. Rebates will not be issued retroactively for items purchased prior to January 1, 2014.
 - ◆ An on-site inspection by a representative of the Water Department may be required to verify installation before a rebate is paid. Buildings that apply for a rebate after installing five or more clothes washers will require an inspection.
 - ◆ Toilets, urinals, and washers must meet the following standards to qualify for a rebate:
 - Urinals— 0.5 gallons per flush (gpf)
 - Toilets— High Efficiency Toilets (HETs) 1.28 gpf; Ultra High Efficiency Toilets (UHETs) 1.0 gpf
 - Clothes washers must be ENERGY STAR certified
 - ◆ The following **apply only** to High Efficiency Toilets (HETs). For Ultra High Efficiency Toilets (UHETs), see blue-box below:
 - High Efficiency Toilets (1.28 gpf or less) are eligible for rebates only if they replace older toilets that use 3.5 gallons per flush or more.
 - New construction or remodel projects requiring a building permit do not qualify for toilet or urinal rebates.
 - Persons selling or buying property are eligible for toilet or urinal rebates only if they have complied with all requirements of the Plumbing Fixture Retrofit Ordinance. Rebates are not available if a Notice of Violation has been issued on the property.
 - Properties previously certified by the Plumbing Fixture Retrofit Ordinance are not eligible for a toilet or urinal rebate. You may call the Water Conservation Office at 831-420-5230 to find out if your property has a Water Conservation Certificate on file.
- ◆ **Ultra High Efficiency Toilets have a maximum of 1.0 gpf (dual flush not included) and are eligible for a rebate regardless** of the type of toilet replaced, whether a property has received a Water Conservation Certificate, or whether the property is undergoing a new construction or remodeling project requiring a building permit.
- ◆ Leases (**effective July 1, 2014**) for clothes washers are only accepted if:
 - The Lease Agreement is for a minimum of five years—a copy of which must be submitted with this application, and
 - A **commercial** Energy Star clothes washer is installed—i.e. residential clothes washers qualify only with an original sale.

Procedure

1. Purchase and install your toilet(s), urinal(s), or clothes washer(s). To find out how various toilet makes and models are rated in terms of flushing performance, go to www.map-testing.com. The higher the MaP rating, the better the flushing performance. To find out how various ENERGY STAR qualified clothes washers are rated in terms of energy and water savings, go to www.energystar.gov.
2. Complete this form and attach the **original** sales receipt or itemized plumber's invoice for toilets or urinals, or a **copy** of the receipt or Lease Agreement for clothes washers. Return to the City of Santa Cruz Water Department for processing.
3. Allow four weeks from the date the application was received to obtain your rebate.
4. Businesses within city limits may recycle old toilets at the City Recycling Center on Dimeo Lane free of charge. Businesses outside city limits may recycle toilets at the Buena Vista Landfill for a small fee. Please remove the seat and hardware prior to drop off.
