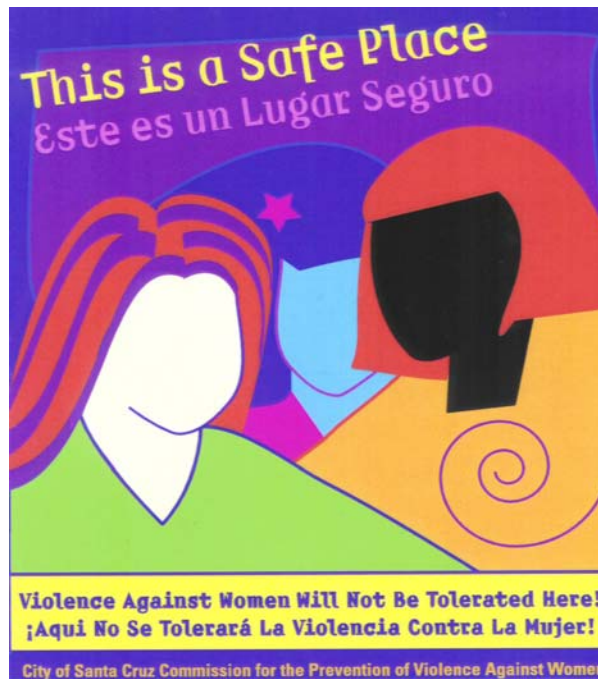

The Safe Place Network Program

The Safe Place Network Program was established in October of 1999 to build a network of spaces in the City of Santa Cruz for those who feel frightened or threatened.

We welcome your business to join the many others that currently are participating.

Business owners: Contact the Commission for the Prevention of Violence Against Women at 420-5363 to participate in this network. A fifteen-minute orientation will be scheduled to provide information and materials of the program for your employees and staff.

Your part as a *Safe Place Network Participant*

- Affix a decal in a prominent position such as a front door or window.
- Provide access, for someone who feels frightened or threatened, to a telephone and a place to wait for support from police, local agencies, family or friend.
- Offer resource cards to those who might be seeking help regarding their safety (including harassment, sexual assault, stalking, and domestic violence). All referrals are listed on resource cards.
- Provide *Safe Place Network Program* information to new employees during their initial training.
