


## You are invited to be a part of the Safe Place Network Program!

### The Safe Place Network Program

The Safe Place Network Program was established in October of 1999 to build a network of spaces in the City of Santa Cruz for those who feel frightened or threatened.

We welcome your business to join the many others that currently are participating.

**Business owners:** Contact the Commission for the Prevention of Violence Against Women at 420-5363 to participate in this network. A fifteen-minute orientation will be scheduled to provide information and materials of the program for your employees and staff.

#### Your part as a *Safe Place Network Participant*

- Affix a decal in a prominent position such as a front door or window.
- Provide access, for someone who feels frightened or threatened, to a telephone and a place to wait for support from police, local agencies, family or friend.
- Offer resource cards to those who might be seeking help regarding their safety (including harassment, sexual assault, stalking, and domestic violence). All referrals are listed on resource cards.
- Provide *Safe Place Network Program* information to new employees during their initial training.
